2. The software is provided as a license to use for a limited period of time.
3. The software is provided for use by the licensed individual only.
4. The software must not be made accessible outside of the country in which it is licensed or the countries explicitly listed in this application without prior approval of Petrosys.
5. The software is provided solely for the purpose of training in the use of Petrosys software, surface modeling, and geomatics in general; and for academic research projects.
6. The software must not be used for comparisons with other applications or other forms of competitive evaluations; for paid consulting work or for commercial operations of any form; or for the control of moving vessels, vehicles or aircraft of any form.
7. Where a research project is sponsored by a commercial organization, reports and presentations to or with that organization that include content generated by Petrosys software should acknowledge Petrosys as having provided the software.
8. When a research project requires an extension of the license, a brief written summary of the use of the software in the project must be provided with the application for extension.
